

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE SEBASTIAN RIVER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ESTABLISHING A FORMAL PROCEDURE PROVIDING THE PUBLIC A REASONABLE OPPORTUNITY TO BE HEARD ON A PROPOSITION BEFORE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Sebastian River Improvement District's Board of Supervisors desires to adopt a formal procedure to allow the public the opportunity to be heard prior to Board decisions; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Sebastian River Improvement District desires to adopt a policy in accordance with current laws of the State of Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Sebastian River Improvement District, that the Board shall adopt a policy and procedure concerning the right of the public to be heard prior to a vote taken by the Board of Supervisors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that procedures for the Board of Supervisors' actions in any matter to be voted on shall be as follows;

1. The chair shall place the issue before the body of the Board.
2. Comments will be receive from District Staff, which will include but not be limited to the District Administrator; Attorney; Engineer; Accountant.
3. Board members shall question staff as applicable.
4. Open public comment. (Board members shall question as applicable presenters in regard to projects under permit applications review by the staff of the Sebastian River Improvement District and brought before the Board for Board action)
5. Close public comment.
6. Consideration of a motion to adopt; reject or defer the agenda item.
7. Second on the motion
8. Board of Supervisor debate.
9. Vote

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said comments shall be limited to three (3) minute per person, however, five minutes shall be reserved for any representative of a group of 5 or more. Each person is limited to speak once during public comment for each issue on the agenda and/or brought before the Board of Supervisors.
